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PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Youth Job Connection: Summer is open to all eligible youth aged 15 to 18, with a focus on those who are experiencing challenging life situations and are at risk of experiencing poor transitions between education and work. These young people may be facing difficulties in school that increases the risk of not graduating. Or they may have barriers to accessing post-secondary education, such as low school performance, lack of financial resources, problems with family life, or problems in the community. Others may be hampered by individual behaviour issues, such as lack of motivation, low confidence, a sense of detachment or feeling isolated.

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PROGRAM GOALS:

This program is designed to help young people between the ages of 15 and 18 who face challenging life situations. It provides them with pre-employment training and work opportunities that will help them make informed career and educational planning decisions as they embark on their careers.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES:

The program helps participants to make informed educational and career planning decisions by providing:

Opportunities to learn employment readiness skills for initial work experiences.

Access to job placements career development resources to increase their knowledge of employment and career options and the job market.

Education and work transitions support to help plan for the future.
